

Dear Examinee,

Thank you for registering for the Psychometric Entrance Test. Please read the following explanations and guidelines about the test.

When you enter the testing room, you will be asked to present your ID card. If you do not have an Israeli ID card, show the passport you used to register for the test. Remember: without an ID card or a valid passport, you will not be allowed to take the test! After the proctors verify your identity, they will give you an essay sheet and an answer sheet with your name printed on them. The proctors will instruct you to place your bags at the front of the room and will direct you to your seat. Check that the name and ID number printed on the answer sheets that you were given are correct.

1. When the test begins, the proctors will read instructions in Hebrew. A summary of these instructions appears here: [Guidelines for examinees](#). Please note:
 - ◆ It is absolutely forbidden to have a mobile phone in your possession during the test, even if it is switched off! Before the test, you must switch off your mobile phone and put it in your bag or on the proctors' desk.
 - ◆ If you do not feel well and are unable to take the test, raise your hand and inform the proctors.
 - ◆ Place your ID card or passport on your desk.
2. After the instructions are read, and before the test begins, you will be told to copy the declaration appearing at the bottom of the answer sheet. If you cannot write in Hebrew, wait until the proctors hand out the test booklets. On the back of the test booklet, you will find the declaration written in the language the test is being given in, and you may copy it from there. On the back of the test booklet you will also find additional instructions. Read them carefully. At this point, you are not allowed to open the test booklet under any circumstances! After you have finished reading the instructions on the back of the booklet, write your full name on the upper left side of the booklet's cover, and write the number of the booklet in the place designated for it on the answer sheet.
3. During the test:
 - ◆ Going to the restroom is allowed only with the permission of the proctors and only if escorted by a proctor. You will not be compensated for any time lost going to the restroom.
 - ◆ The first section of the test is a writing task. Instructions and explanations for the writing task can be found here: [Writing Task](#). At the end of the time allotted for the writing task, you must stop writing and close the test booklet. The proctors will go around the room and collect the essay sheets. During this time, you may not write anything, open the test booklet, or go to the restroom. After the essay sheets are collected, the proctors will explain how to fill out the answer sheet that you will use for the second part of the test. 4. At the end of the test, you will be told to close the test booklet and remain in your seat. At this time, nothing may be added to the answer sheet. The proctors will collect the answer sheets and test booklets and will hand out a *Feedback Questionnaire*. You are not required to fill out this questionnaire, but we would appreciate your doing so. As you leave the room, you will be given an exam confirmation slip. The reference number appearing on this slip serves as the personal code that allows you to access your scores online.
